Scripture readings for Thursday: **Epistle:** 2 Thessalonians §276 [2:13-3:5] (25<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §62 [11:47-12:1] (24<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

## Friday, November 4

Bright vestments. Weekday service for Friday.

Scripture readings of Friday: **Epistle:** 2 Thessalonians §277 [3:6:18] (25<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §63 [12:2-12] (24<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

### Saturday, November 5

The Holy Martyrs Galaction and Epistemis. Dark vestments. Weekday service for Saturday. Scripture readings of Saturday: **Epistle:** Galatians §199 [1:3:10] (25<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §40 [9:1-6] (24<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

### Sunday, November 6 25<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost

Our Holy Father Paul, Archbishop of Constantinople and Confessor (c. 353-61). **Tone 8. Matins Gospel III.** Bright vestments. Resurrection Service in Tone 8. Scripture readings of Sunday: **Epistle:** Ephesians §224 [4:1-6] (25<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §39 [8:41-56] (24<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

### Monday, November 7

The Thirty-three Holy Martyrs of Militene (284-305); Our Venerable Father and Wonderworker Lazarus, Hermit of Mount Galesius (1054). Dark vestments. Weekday service for Monday. Scripture readings of Monday: **Epistle:** 1 Timothy §278 [1:1-7] (26<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §65 [12:13-15; 22-31] (25<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

### **Tuesday, November 8**

±Synaxis of the Archangel Michael and the Other Bodiless Powers of Heaven.

Bright vestments. Service for November 8. Scripture readings for November 8: **Epistle:** Hebrews §305 [2:2-10] (26<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §51 [10:16-21] (25<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

### Wednesday, November 9

The Holy Martyrs Onisiphorus and Porphyry (456-474); Our Venerable Mother Matrona (456-74); the Venerable Theoctista of Lesbos. Dark vestments. Weekday Service for Wednesday Scripture readings of Wednesday: **Epistle:** 1 Timothy §281 [1:18-20; 2:8-15] (26<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §69 [12:48-59] (25<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

#### Thursday, November 10

The Holy Apostles Erastus, Olympus, Rodion and Those with them. Bright vestments. Weekday Service for Thursday. Scripture readings of Thursday: **Epistle**: 1 Timothy §283 [3:1-13] (26<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke § 70 [13:1-9] (25<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

## Friday, November 11

The Holy Martyrs Menas, Victor and Vincent (138-61); Our Venerable Father and Confessor Theodore the Studite (826). Dark vestments. Weekday service for Friday. Scripture readings of Friday: **Epistle:** 1 Timothy §285 [4:4-8; 16] (26<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §73 [13:31-35] (25<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

## Saturday, November 12

**±The Holy Priest-Martyr Josaphat, Archbishop of Polotsk (1623).** Our Holy Father John the Compassionate, Patriarch of Alexandria (619); Our Venerable Father Nilus (430).
Dark vestments. Service for November 12 (St. Josaphat).
Scripture readings from Common for a Bishop:
Epistle: Hebrews §311 [4:14-5:10].
Gospel: John §36 [10:9-16].

## Sunday, November 13 26<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost

## +Our Holy Father John Chrysostom, Archbishop of Constantinople (407). Tone 1. Matins Gospel IV.

Bright vestments. Resurrection tropar (tone 1); Tropar of the Saint; GLORY: Resurrection Kondak; NOW: Kondak of the Saint; Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of Sunday and of the Saint. Scripture readings of Sunday:

**Epistle:** Ephesians §229 [5:9-19] (26<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §53 [10:25-37] (25<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

## Monday, November 14

+The Holy and All-Praiseworthy Apostle Philip.

Bright vestments. Service for October 14. Scripture readings for St. Philip: **Epistle:** 1 Corinthians §131 [4:9-16]. **Gospel:** John §5 [1:43-51].

## Tuesday, November 15

The Holy Martyrs and Confessors Gurias, Samonas (284-305) and Abibus (313-24). Dark vestments. Weekday Service for Tuesday. Scripture readings of Tuesday: **Epistle:** 1 Timothy §286 [5:11-21] (27<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §77 [14:25-35] (26<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

*Note:* Philip's Fast (Pylypivka), the pre-Christmas fast which begins today – the day after the feast of St. Philip – is a 40 days period of spiritual preparation for the celebration of the Nativity/Theophany cycle of the church year. It was once a period of strict fasting, which has now been abrogated in favor of voluntary fasting and works of penance.

Dark vestments are the norm for this penitential season with exception of Saturdays, Sundays and feasts of the first class.

Wednesday, November 16 +The Holy Apostle and Evangelist Matthew. Bright vestments. Service for November 16 (St. Mathews). Scripture readings from the Common for an Apostle: **Epistle:** 1 Corinthians §131 [4:9-16]. **Gospel:** Matthew §30 [9:9-13].

## Thursday, November 17

Our Holy Father Gregory the Wonderworker, Bishop of Neocaesarea (270-75). Bright vestments. Weekday Service for Thursday. Scripture readings of Thursday: **Epistle**: 1 Timothy §289 [6:17-21] (27<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel**: Luke §80 [16:1-9] (26<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

### Friday, November 18

The Holy Martyrs Plato (286-305) and Roman (305). Dark vestments. Weekday service for Friday. Scripture readings of Friday: **Epistle:** 2 Timothy §290a [1:1, 2, 8-18] (27<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §82 [16:15-18; 17:1-4] (26<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

### Saturday, November 19

The Holy Prophet Obadiah; the Holy Martyr Barlaam. Bright vestments. Weekday Service for Saturday. Scripture readings of Saturday: **Epistle:** Galatians §213[5:22-6:2] (27<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §49 [9:57-62] (26<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

### Sunday, November 20 27<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost

Forefeast of the Entrance of the Most Holy Mother of God into the Temple; Our Venerable Father Gregory of Decapolis (482); Our Holy Father Proclus, Archbishop of Constantinople (446). *Commemoration of Blessed Josaphata Hordashevska, First Superior of the Sisters Servants of Mary Immaculate* (+1919).

### Tone 2. Matins Gospel V.

Bright vestments. Resurrection tropar (tone 2); Tropar of the Forefeast; GLORY: Resurrection kondak; NOW: Kondak of the Forefeast. Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of Sunday only. Scripture readings: **Epistle:** Ephesians §233 [6:10-17] (27<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §66 [12:16-21] (26<sup>th</sup> Week after Pentecost).

### Monday, November 21

The Entrance into the Temple of our Most Holy Lady, the Mother of God and Ever-Virgin Mary. Blue vestments. Service for November 21, including proper hirmos.
Scripture readings for the Feast:
Epistle: Hebrew §320 [9:1-7].
Gospel: Luke §54 [10:38-42; 11:27-28].

### **Tuesday, November 22**

Post-feast of the Entrance of the Mother of God; The Holy Apostle Philemon and Those with Him. Blue vestments. Service for November 21, including proper hirmos. Scripture readings of Tuesday: **Epistle:** 2 Timothy §297 [3:16-4:4] (28<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §87 [17:26-37] (27<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost).

### Wednesday, November 23

Post-feast of the Entrance of the Mother of God; Our Holy Father Amphilochius, Bishop of Iconium (4<sup>th</sup> c.) and Gregory, Bishop of Agrigentum (7<sup>th</sup> c.). Blue vestments. Service for November 21, including proper hirmos. Scripture readings for Wednesday: **Epistle:** 2 Timothy §299 [4:9-22] (28<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §90 [18:15-17; 26-30] (27<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost).

## **Thursday, November 24 Civil Holiday**: Thanksgiving Day.

Post-feast of the Entrance of the Mother of God; The Holy Great-Martyr Catherine (310-13); the Holy Great-Martyr Mercurius (249-51). Blue vestments. Service for November 21, including proper hirmos. Scripture readings for Thursday **Epistle:** Titus §300 [1:5-2:1] (28<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §92 [18:31-34] (27<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost).

## (For a Thanksgiving Day Liturgy:

Propers for Thanksgiving. Including Thanksgiving petitions in the Ektenia. The Prayer of Thanksgiving (cf. Molytvennyk) may be said after the Ambo Prayer. Scripture readings for a Thanksgiving Day: **Epistle:** Ephesians §229 [5:9-21].

**Gospel:** Luke §85 [17:12-19].)

## Friday, November 25

Leave-taking of the Entrance of the Mother of God; Our Holy Father and Priest-martyr Clement, Pope of Rome (101); Peter, Bishop of Alexandria (312). Blue vestments. Service for November 21, including proper hirmos. Scripture readings for Friday: **Epistle:** Titus §301 [1:15-2:10] (28<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §95 [19:12-28] (27<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost).

## Saturday, November 26

Our Venerable Father Alypius the Stylite (610); the Blessing of the Church of the Holy Great-Martyr George which is in Kiev, before the Gates of Holy Wisdom Cathedral (1019-54). Bright vestments. Weekly service for Saturday. Scripture readings for Saturday: **Epistle:** Ephesians §218 [1:16-23] (28<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §51 [10:19-21] (27<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost).

## Sunday, November 27 28<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost

The Holy Martyr James of Persia (422); Our Venerable Father Palladius. **Tone 3. Matins Gospel VI.** Bright Vestments. Resurrection service in tone 3. Scripture readings of Sunday: **Epistle:** Colossians §250 [1:12-18] (28<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost). **Gospel:** Luke §71 [13:10-17].
