Blue vestments. Resurrection Tropar (Tone 4); Tropar of the Presentation; *Glory:/Now:* Kondak of the Presentation. Prokimen, Alleluia Verses, and Communion Hymn of Sunday (Tone 4).

Saturday, February 23 All Souls—First Memorial Saturday

The commemoration of the Holy Priest Martyr Polycarp, bishop of Smyrna (155-56).

Dark vestments. Services for Saturday of the Meatfare Sunday, including Typical Antiphons.

Scripture reading for Saturday of Meatfare Sunday:

Epistle: 1 Corinthians §146 [10:23-28].

Gospel: Luke §105 [21:8-9; 25-27; 33-36].

Note: Panakhyda with general commemoration of the deceased is celebrated following the Ambon Prayer, beginning with the Tropar *So duchy pravednykh*. Following the “Amen” of the Exclamation, the celebrant returns to the Ambon from which he imparts the Final Blessing and the Dismissal proper to the Divine Liturgy. Close with *Vichnaya Pam'yat*.

Sunday, February 24 Meatfare Sunday

First and Second Finding of the Precious Head of the Holy, Glorious Prophet and Forerunner John the Baptist. Our Venerable Father Erasmus.

Tone 7. Matins Gospel VII.

Bright vestments. Resurrection tropar (Tone 7); Tropar of the Baptist; Glory/Now: Kondak of Meatfare Sunday. Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of Meatfare Sunday.

Scripture readings for Meatfare Sunday:

Epistle: 1 Corinthians §140 [8:8-9:2].

Gospel: Matthew §106 [25:31-46].
